People

- Hired and recruited 3 URM faculty members.
- Admitted the most diverse doctoral cohort ever. This in a year with double the number of applications, proportional increases in every demographic, and suspended GRE requirement
- All faculty participated in evaluating IDEAL post-doc applicants

Structure

- Established an [Inclusion Council](#) of faculty, students, staff, and alumni with the goal of advising the GSE on its ongoing efforts to create a more inclusive school.

Funding

- The dean's Learning Collaboration Fund is supporting student scholarship and affinity groups with a dozen grants to groups such as “Black and Brown Identity Collective (B²IC)” and “Building an Anti-Racist GSE.”

Communication

- Established a "[Report an Incident](#)" function in the Fall of 2020 as another means of reaching out to the GSE's Chief Inclusion Officer Eric Abrams concerning acts of bias or intolerance.
